EDUCATION

Advanced Management Program for Infrastructure

As part of its vision, the institute offers an "Advanced Management Programme for Infrastructure Management" (AMPI). The AMPI is a specialized programme blending online and on-campus learning spread over a year and seeks to develop top-level leadership in the infrastructure and real estate sectors. The first batch of the program started in 2016. The fourth batch is currently in progress.

The participants attending the fourth offering of the program are from reputed public and private organizations. The average work experience of the class is 11.6 years. The students come from organizations such as the National Highways Authority of India, Punjab Infrastructure Development Board, Larsen & Toubro, VMart, Airport Authority of India, Petroleum Development Oman, BHEL, Buildcon, etc.

A Study of Domestic Penetration and Export Potential of Premium Cars from India

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between ISB and BMW Group India. ISB had approached BMW to give a research grant for studying how India can become an international hub for the manufacturing of high-end cars in India. Our research project investigated domestic penetration and the export potential of premium cars from India. As part of this research, the following activities have been carried out:

- A survey was conducted among 161 prospective customers (ISB Alumni) for studying consumer behaviour.
- A survey was conducted among 35 distributors of premium cars in six cities of India Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai, Bangalore, Chandigarh, and Ludhiana to study consumer behavior.

- Secondary Research: We made a comparison of the policies and taxation for domestic sales, manufacturing, and exports of luxury cars in India with countries including Brazil, China, Mexico, and Thailand.
- International benchmarking of auto manufacturing and best practices in promoting passenger car sales and exports
- Quantitative and Qualitative analysis of production, domestic sales, premium car sales and export data among India, China, Thailand, Brazil and Mexico
- Analysis of primary consumer and distributor surveys

We submitted the report to the client in August 2019. The client appreciated our findings and insights.

Case Study

We are planning to write a case study on "Ahmedabad Smart City." We have collected relevant data but yet to get approval from the client to progress the case. Professor Chandan conducted a session on Ahmedabad Smart City initiatives for the students of the Advanced Management Program for Infrastructure.

• **Talk by Mr. Nagendra Nath Sinha**: Mr. Nagendra Nath Sinha, Chairman, National Highway Authority of India, addressed the students of the Advanced Management Program for Infrastructure and Advanced Management Program for Manufacturing &
