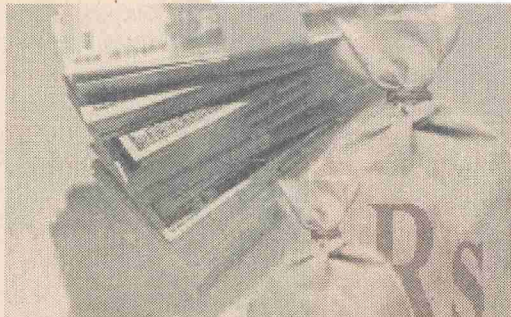


# International offers increase in ISB placements

Placements at the Indian School of Business (ISB), Hyderabad, have become truly global with the number of new international companies visits doubling to 41 which is perhaps for the first time in its record. The 111 international offers are spread across 23 cities across the US, Europe, Middle East and Asia-Pacific and the offers encompass a wide range of functions and industries such as consulting, manufacturing, real estate, IT and others.

Announcing the final results of placements for the Class of 2008, which has surpassed all the previous year's records, Prof Ramchandra Rao, Dean, said that the average Indian CTC offered to ISB students this year is about Rs 19,00,000 which is actually double

have decided to highlight the placement trends and will not be revealing the highest and lowest paid salaries as in a Class of 450, it would not give a clear picture of the entire class performance," he said adding that this is inline with the international B-Schools tradition.
