

ISB ranked 12th in top global B-school list

MUMBAI: The Indian School of Business (ISB) has been ranked 12th in the 2010 Financial Times Global MBA ranking, three notches up from the 15th rank in 2009. It's the only Indian B-school to be placed in the list of top-100 schools. "Till December 2008, we did not realise that the placements of the 2009 batch will be so difficult," said Ajit Rangnekar, Dean, ISB. In fact, like other B-schools in the country, the placement season at ISB went on till July as job offers were delayed. London Business School, University of Pennsylvania at Wharton and the Harvard Business School, respectively, occupied the top three ranks. Besides ISB, four institutes from China made it in the top 100 list from Asia. Hong Kong UST Business School from China ranked 9th. Previously, in 2008, ISB was ranked 20th, making it the first Indian business school to be counted among the world's top 20.
