

Venture investment competition ay ISB

The Indian School of Business (ISB) recently hosted Asia's first strategy competition — Venture Capital Investment Competition (VCIC) — in Hyderabad, in which students analysed, negotiated term sheets and picked a venture to invest. Teams from B-schools across Asia, including China Europe International Business School, IIM-Bangalore, Cheung Kong Graduate School of Business and Nanyang Technological University, participated.

National University of Singapore emerged as the winner of the Asia region final. The winning team will now head for the international finals to be held at the Kenan Flagler Business School, University of North Carolina in April. Some of the business plans presented by the teams were Content Syndicate — a platform for buying and selling content for publications; Serial Innovations — a plan to empower government and industry to see, understand and control complex environments; Black Gold Eco Market Watch — a plan for managing waste produced by the residential communities in the cities and i4t5 — a plan for securing online transactions ■
